



RED DEER REGIONAL AIRPORT - OPERATIONS SPECIALIST

The Red Deer Regional Airport operates as an affordable and sustainable regional airport that serves our community with safety, security, and service. Our facilities can accommodate public community events, full air services and is home to a flight school with capacity for growth and continued development. We are Alberta's Low-Cost Airport, and we look forward to continuing to grow for the community.

Reporting to the Director, Airport Operations, the Airport Operations Specialist contributes to the safe and reliable operations of the Red Deer Regional Airport and the safe passage of the traveling public by maintaining the airport surfaces and structures in operable conditions. This includes clearing and maintaining runways, taxiways, aprons and roads, drainage systems, buildings, and other associated tasks.

Responsibilities:

Maintenance

- Perform daily safe and effective operations and maintenance on runways, taxiways, aprons supporting plant, roadways, and equipment with both indoor and outdoor labor required in all types of weather conditions.
- Conduct Canadian Runway Friction Index (CRFI) tests as required and reports/removes Foreign Object Debris.
- Maintain a close working relationship with NAV Canada.
- Use ice control chemicals and materials for snow and ice control (SNIC).
- Operate heavy equipment such as snow blowers, plow trucks, winter sweepers, loaders, and associated equipment.
- Identify and assist with any required equipment repairs.
- Install, maintain, and repair fencing and signage.
- Identify unsafe surfaces and repairs as required.
- Perform bird and wildlife control.
- Provide surface maintenance and vegetation control.

Qualifications

- Working knowledge of TP312 is considered an asset.
- Mechanic expertise would be considered an asset.
- Ability to work independently and in a team.
- Focus on safety and respect for the equipment.
- The position requires the following licenses and certificates or the ability to obtain them.
 - Class 5 drivers license with air endorsement.
 - Restricted radio operator's license.
 - Airside vehicle operator's license (AVOP).
 - WHMIS Certificate.
 - First Aid Course.
